What is ASES?

ASES is an after school program that provides a safe environment for students to get help with their homework, have access to technology, recreation, and enrichment activities such as Art, karate, and science experiments.

Who can join ASES?

Students in grades first-sixth may apply for ASES. Students are accepted into the program if they meet the criteria of needing/wanting extra help with their studies and have good attendance.

When does ASES meet?

ASES meets from 3:00-6:00 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, and from 1:30-6:00 p.m. on Wednesdays. If school is in session, so is ASES.
