REVIEW OF MINUTES

TREASURER'S REPORT

Leslie Collins reported the current balance with sub accounts is \$21,598.95. Sub accounts are accounts that are under the PTC umbrella, but are not part of the general funds. Profit should be around 3-4 thousand once everyone is paid and food vendors give us their 15%.
