Old Business

- ❖ Donuts With Dad went well. 791.00 profit. Running it through the snack bar and sitting in the staff lot was hassle free. A little chilly but clean-up was easy.
- ❖ Book Fair/Kahoot Night: We were upgraded to a bigger fair. It ran well. Sales up from previous year. Cash profit was 1577.24, not including books taken from fair for library. Teachers appreciated the gift of 50.00 to spend, from PTC.

New Business

- ❖ Santa's Secret Shop: December 3-7, 2018. Need lots of volunteers, only open during school hours. PTC uses Penguin Patch. Not a big money maker. We only earn 10% profit –to keep prices low so more kids can shop. We need help with set up on Nov 30th. Library will close at lunch to set up.
- ❖ Sonora: Sweatshirts and money for students: this is a "gift" PTC has done in the past for the students to spend in Columbia on a Jaw Breaker or Sarsaparilla. This will be for approximately 85 students. Board approves this request. PTC also purchases commemorative sweatshirts for all students, chaperones and teachers. This year an order form was used to alleviate confusion.
- ❖ GATE/5th grade Science request: Mr. Watkins is requesting help with purchasing materials needed for Science projects. PTC helped last year. Melodie Polsgrove and Leslie Collins approve the request of 500.00 to help fund the supplies needed.
