INFORMATION ON SIERRA OUTDOOR SCHOOL FOR 6TH GR STUDENTS

- Sonora is scheduled for December 1-3, 2021.
- All parents who are interested in being a chaperone must submit their name to the classroom teacher ASAP.
- Parents must have completed their online volunteer application (on the Weldon Website) with attached TB clearance and COVID Vaccination Card.
- The Weldon School Nurse, Sarah Roberts, R.N., will be at the meeting on 10/21 @ 5:30pm to process TB forms for those needing them.
- Chaperones must be fingerprinted (through CUSD) and that cannot happen until all required forms have been submitted.
- The cost for each student and/or chaperone to attend is \$225.00 each.
- 6th grade students may sell candy to help with the cost of the trip. Students will receive \$30.00 per sold case toward their Sonora cost. Students must submit payment for case checked out before receiving another case to sell. If a student sells 8 cases, this will pay their way to Sonora.
