Teacher Spotlight: Rick Ferguson

Mr. Ferguson- is retiring after 26 years of teaching service to Weldon. He was interviewed by PTC Board Member Joy Badigue and shares his thoughts.

1. Fondest Memory from Weldon:

There are many fond memories from my 26 years of teaching and 29 years as a wrestling coach. In 2020, the Doc Buchanan Wrestling Invitational Tournament was dedicated to me for my years of coaching wrestling at Weldon and support for the Clovis High School wrestling program. It means a great deal to me today because my sons Scott and Brett were there with their families, as was my wife Cheryl, who passed away the following year. As a teacher, it was a fond memory watching my first group of third graders go forward and graduate from Clovis High.



2. How long have you been a Warrior?

My oldest son Scott began school in Mrs. Lambert's kindergarten class at Weldon in 1990. I was not a teacher until 1997, but that is when I became a Warrior. In 1994, my other son Brett entered kindergarten, and I started coaching wrestling at Weldon. I was hooked. My teaching career at Weldon began in 1997 when Principal Scott Steele hired me to teach third grade.

3. Favorite Author?

My favorite author is Michael Crichton, who wrote Jurassic Park and many other thrillers. Many of his novels involve far out science theory, but he explains the science which makes his plots plausible. One of my favorite novels by Michael Crichton is Timeline, a science fiction story about a wealthy Silicon Valley entrepreneur who sends a group of scientists and archeologists back in time to medieval France.

4. The Best Vacation Spot:

My best vacation spot is Avila Beach near San Luis Obispo. I often go in the late fall when there is little traffic and hotel rooms are easier to get. I enjoy walking the Bob Jones Trail which takes you from the beach to the famous Avila Barn. It is absolutely the most relaxing place to visit.
